

**GEORGIA COMPOSITE MEDICAL BOARD
MINUTES
DECEMBER 4, 2014**

CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Retterbush called the meeting of the Georgia Composite Medical Board to order at 7:30 AM.

AGENDA

Dr. White submitted a motion, seconded by Dr. Sightler, to approve the agenda of the December 4, 2014 meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

MINUTES

Dr. Sightler submitted a motion, seconded by Dr. Antalis, to approve the minutes of the November 6-7, 2014 meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

OATH OF OFFICE

Dr. Retterbush administered the oath of office to Adrian Lee Cliett, Medical Board Agent.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR’S REPORT

LaSharn Hughes, Executive Director, presented the following information for the Board’s review. Dr. Gross submitted a motion, seconded by Dr. Powell, to accept the report. The motion carried unanimously. The Board took the following actions:

1. Received information about the latest version of legislation to provide for the medical use of cannabis oil.

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2. Received information about the continued efforts by Healthy Mothers Healthy Babies Coalition of Georgia to pass legislation requiring licensure for lactation consultants.
3. Received an update regarding physician profiles: Between December 1 and December 3, 2014, the Board mailed letters warning of possible referral for license suspension to approximately 600 physicians who have failed to submit physician profiles in compliance with O.C.G.A. 43-34A; approximately 600 more physicians will be sent the letter the week of December 8, 2014.
4. Ms. Wray discussed an article, “Officials free to divulge executive session talks,” and advised the Board that although members may voluntarily waive attorney/client privilege and disclose legal counsel concerning general matters, they are not permitted to disclose information discussed in executive session about specific cases or individuals. She added that if a member is sued for doing so, he or she is personally liable and is not entitled to legal representation by the Attorney General. The Board accepted the counsel as information.
5. Considered a question, “May aestheticians perform cosmetic radiofrequency, ultrasound, and microneedling procedures?” Dr. Gross submitted a motion, seconded by Dr. Antalis, that the Board adopt the position that cosmetic radiofrequency and ultrasound procedures are the practice of medicine, and therefore cannot be performed by persons not licensed to practice medicine, unless they are directly supervised by a licensed physician. The motion carried unanimously. The issue of microneedling procedures was tabled for future discussion.
6. Reviewed an inquiry from Melana McClatchey, representing the Georgia Dental Association: “May military physicians stationed in Georgia, but who do not hold active Georgia licenses, provide uncompensated medical care for a charitable organization?” The Board responded that such physicians need Georgia licensure as physicians or as volunteers in medicine to practice medicine outside a military installation, and asked Ms. Hughes to forward information on the application process to Ms. McClatchey.
7. Dr. Gross submitted a motion, seconded by Dr. Powell, to amend Rule 360-3-.07 “Practice Through Electronic or Other Such Means” to add a statement to clarify the Board’s interpretation of 360-3-.07(8)(b) that the treating physician, not the patient, determines who is on call when the physician is unavailable.
8. Received a letter from Edith Utley PA-C, representing Southeast Lung Associates, asking the Board to support legislation which would authorizing a physician to delegate to a PA the authority to prescribe schedule II controlled medications. The Board accepted the letter as information.
9. Received a letter from Victoria Kay McLeod, RN, CRNA, asking the Board to reinstate the license of T.R. Shantha, MD. The Board accepted the letter as information.
10. Received a letter from the Right Reverend Mr. Gregory Karl Davis entitled “Motion to Correct the Record, Georgia Composite Medical Board Meeting Minutes,” and referred the letter to the Board’s attorney for clarification as to the nature of Mr. Davis’s specific request.
11. Reviewed the article, “Need a quick diagnosis? A prescription for what ails you? The doctor will chat with you now.”
12. Reviewed the article, “Dr. Jean Sumner appointed associate dean for rural health in (Mercer) School of Medicine.” The Board resolved to send Dr. Sumner a letter expressing the Board’s appreciation for her many years of public service to the people of Georgia during her tenure with the Board as a member and as the medical director.
13. Reviewed the article, “Cannabis oil clinical trial at Georgia Regents University might not be only option.”
14. Received an inquiry from Karen Eaves of General Produce LLC requesting clarification of how the company might be able to comply with the requirements of O.C.G.A. 31-11-53.1, which mandates the “involvement of a licensed physician or other person authorized by the

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- composite board in (a) site's automated external defibrillator program to ensure compliance with requirements for training, notification, and maintenance".
15. Received information from the Federation of State Medical Boards (FSMB) calling for nominations to the FSMB Board of Directors and the FSMB Nominating Committee.
 16. Received information from the FSMB concerning ten scholarships being made available for state medical board public members who have served no more than two years or have not attended a previous FSMB annual meeting.
 17. Received a letter from the Board of Directors of the Optometric Society expressing the organization's concerns with Rule 360-3-.07 "Practice Through Electronic or Other Such Means" and its possible impact on the use of online eye examinations and online patient medical/ocular history questionnaires for contact lens prescriptions.
 18. Received information about a Utah statute, Health Care Professional Truth in Advertising, from Joseph P. Finley, MD. The Board accepted the information.
 19. Received a draft of the FY 2014 annual report and December 2014 Board newsletter for its review and approval.
 20. Patricia Yeatts of the Medical Association of Georgia informed the Board that MAG intended to address concerns about abandoned medical records, and invited the Board to refer any questions concerning abandoned medical records to her.
 21. Considered a letter from Thomas J. Locke III, MD of W.I.S.E. Medical Centers requesting a statement of the Board's position on harvesting stem cells from autologous fat, use of stem cells for medical or surgical and cosmetic treatments, and transferring harvested fat to third-party companies that treat and store fat-derived stem cells for an individual's own future use in treating injuries, malignancies, and/or degenerative diseases. The Board responded that it had no position on these issues, so long as the licensee's practice of medicine met the minimum accepted standard of care.

PRESENTATION BY GEORGIA OFFICE OF RURAL HEALTH

Charles Owens, executive director of the Georgia Office of Rural Health, presented information about community paramedicine, and how it can improve patient outcomes, decrease emergency and acute care hospital utilization, and reduce health care costs.
