LEGAL / ENFORCEMENT ACTION REPORT

- Case # 20111701: Invite respondent to address a panel of Board members to discuss petition to lift certain limitations on license. (Motion by Dr. Gross; seconded by Dr. Retterbush.)
- Case # 20112191: Refer to Attorney General for legal action.
- Case # 20120129: Deny petition to lift certain limitations on license. (Motion by Dr. Weil; seconded by Dr. DeLoach.)
- Kelvin Darnel White, MD (physician license 33753): Accept public consent order placing license on probation for five years, requiring cooperation in board matters, prohibiting licensee from working in a pain clinic, requiring payment of \$5,000.00 fine, and imposing certain other restrictions. LICENSURE COMMITTEE

Dr. Weil presented the Licensure Committee report as a motion. The motion was seconded by Mr. Wallace. The Board accepted the report by unanimous vote.

The Board took the following actions:

1. Informed Dr. Sareen Sapna that the Board would evaluate his USMLE score history only upon submission of an application for licensure.
2. Approved Dr. Ahmed Moussa's request to send a copy of his medical school transcript to the Nevada Medical Board.
3. Declared that the Postgraduate Training Certificate form (Form A) is not required for postgraduate training in public health.
4. Declared that applicants licensed in other states who have failed Step 3 of the USMLE more than three times or took longer than 7 years to pass all three steps may submit an application for review by the Board without being required to submit a petition to waive the rule.
5. Approved Dr. Grecori Anderson's petition to waive Rule 360-2-.02.
6. Tabled an application by J.R. pending the receipt of additional information.
7. Informed J.A. that the Board would reconsider the application for licensure upon receipt of clinical skills examination results.

12. Extended R.N.'s application expiration date to March 2017.
