Dr. Kamath moved to adopt the proposed Rule, and that the Board finds the formulation and adoption of these rules do not impose excessive regulatory cost on any licensee and any cost to comply with the proposed rule can not be reduced by a less expensive alternative that fully accomplishes the objectives of the applicable laws.

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That the Board find that it is not legal or feasible to meet the objectives is the applicable laws to adopt or implement differing actions for businesses as listed at O.C.G.A § 50-13-4 (a) (3) (A), (B), (C), and (D).
