CALL TO ORDER

Dr. House called the meeting of the Georgia Composite Medical Board to order at 7:30 a.m.

AGENDA

Dr. Retterbush submitted a motion, seconded by Dr. White, to approve the agenda of the December 3, 2015 meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

MINUTES

Dr. Weil submitted a motion, seconded by Dr. Retterbush to approve the minutes of the November 5, 2015 meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR’S REPORT

Robert Jeffery, interim Executive Director, presented the following information for the Board’s review. Dr. Weil submitted a motion, seconded by Dr. Gross, to accept the report. The motion carried unanimously. The Board took the following actions:

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1. Referred Marchalee Ellis to the Rules of the Georgia Composite Medical Board and Georgia's state laws, in answer to the following inquiry: Are certain specific examples of prescriptions issued by telemedicine providers allowable?
2. Advised Dr. Carlos Victoria that drug screening Attention-Deficit / Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) patients is not required by the Board, in answer to the following inquiry: Does the Board have guidelines requiring physicians to drug-test patients on ADHD medications?
3. Advised the Governor's Office that Board will use its newsletter to highlight the importance of routinely discussing with patients the effect their diagnosed medical conditions or recommended drugs may have on their ability to safely operate a vehicle, and that including such language in all state guidelines regarding prescribing controlled substances is not within the Board's role. The advice was in response to a letter to the Governor from the National Transportation Safety Board asking how Georgia has implemented two NTSB safety recommendations, 1-14-1 and 1-14-2.
4. Invited Rick Allen, Director of the Georgia Drugs and Narcotics Agency (GDNA), to the January 7, 2016 meeting to discuss the need for a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), and resolved to request written guidance from the Attorney General after the discussion, if necessary. Mr. Allen had sent the Board a letter proposing an MOU regarding investigations GDNA may conduct that involve Medical Board licensees and vaccine protocol registrants.
5. Accepted information regarding the Board's annual report, December newsletter, and future newsletter schedules. The December newsletter and annual report were published December 1, 2015. In January, the Board will begin publishing a monthly newsletter with articles from Board members, advisory committee members, the deans of the Georgia medical schools and other potential contributors.
6. Reviewed Senate Bill 115.
7. Reviewed Senate Bill 230.
8. Adopted a policy of docketing letters of compliance when all terms and conditions imposed by the Board have been satisfied.
9. Reviewed the Low THC Registry Update.

GEORGIA COMMISSION ON MEDICAL CANNABIS

Dr. House has been actively working the Georgia Commission on Medical Cannabis, and gave the Board an update.

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Dr. Marshall submitted a motion to go into closed session to discuss investigative and disciplinary matters. Dr. Retterbush seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Dr. House declared the meeting in open session.

LAW ENFORCEMENT ACTION REPORT

Karl Reimers, Director of Investigations and Enforcement presented the Law Enforcement Action Report. Dr. Gross submitted a motion to approve the report, and Dr. White seconded the motion. The Board accepted the report by unanimous vote.

Dr. Gross asked if anyone was present to address the Board on the posted Rule amendments. No one was present to address the Board.

Dr. Gross made a motion to amend Rule 360-6-.04 "Display of License for Acupuncture;" that the Board find the formulation and adoption of these rules do not impose excessive regulatory cost on any licensee and any cost to comply with the rule cannot be reduced by a less expensive alternative that fully accomplishes the objectives of the applicable laws; that the Board finds that it is not legal or feasible to meet the objectives of the applicable laws to adopt or implement differing actions for businesses as listed in O.C.G.A. 50-13-4(A) (3)(A),(B),(C), and (D).

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Dr. Weil seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.

360-8-.05 “Notifications to the Board”

Dr. Gross asked if anyone was present to address the Board on the posted Rule amendments. No was present to address the Board.

Dr. Gross made a motion to amend Rule 360-8-.085”Notifications to the Board;” that the Board find the formulation and adoption of these rules do not impose excessive regulatory cost on any licensee and any cost to comply with the rule cannot be reduced by a less expensive alternative that fully accomplishes the objectives of the applicable laws; that the Board finds that it is not legal or feasible to meet the objectives of the applicable laws to adopt or implement differing actions for businesses as listed in O.C.G.A. 50-13-4(A) (3)(A),(B),(C), and (D).

Dr. Weil seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.

Dr. Gross asked if anyone was present to address the Board on the posted Rule amendments. No was present to address the Board. The Board reviewed one comment received in mail.
