We establish standards of practice to protect the public from harm, especially as health care becomes more mobile and technology based, and educate doctors about changes that affect the way they practice medicine. The role of the medical boards has never been more important. We must be responsive to change, prepared and actively seeking ways to improve our mission.

Proposed Grant Request

Dr. Sumner presented a proposed grant request and the Board approved submiting.

There being no further business to conduct, Dr. Summers moved that the April 12-13-14, 2007 CSBME meeting be adjourned, Dr. Lewis seconded, and it carried unanimously.
