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NURSE PROTOCOL COMMITTEE

Ms. Kinlaw presented the Committee recommendations report for the Nurse Protocol Committee. Dr. Sumner seconded the Committee recommendations and it carried unanimously.

Other Business:

1. Reviewed DEA registration information from Lem Roberts regarding the fact that the Washington DEA does not require the local DEA office to check with the Medical Board to determine if the APRN has a protocol on file.
2. Reviewed the possibility of APRN's practicing under 26.1 and 26.3 simultaneously and approved to refer the issue to the AG's office pending receipt of information from Karen Schwartz and the Georgia Board of Nursing.
3. Reviewed the rules regarding APRN writing prescriptions, and approved to refer to the rules and laws regarding appropriate standard of care as a response. The committee discussed the terms "medical devices" and "medical Treatments." The committee recommends that since there is no definition in Georgia law for medical devices, to refer to Federal Law for a definition. The committee recommends that medical treatment does not have a set definition in Georgia law.
4. Approved Marian Blaesser to return to the NP committee in January 2009. Dr. Toni Barnett will continue on the committee until the Board of Nursing recommends another member.
