Dr. Kamath declared open session.

PUBLIC HEARING ON RULES

No one appeared to comment on the proposed rules changes;

Dr. Cheeks moved to approve the following rule changes, Dr. Summers seconded, and it carried unanimously.

MOTIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

That the Board adopt the amendments to paragraph (2) of Rule 360-2-.05, entitled "Renewal. Amended.

That the Board adopt the amendments to rule 360-15-.01, entitled "Requirements for Physicians/ Amended."

That the Board adopt the amendments to rule 360-16-.01, entitled "Renewal and Expiration Dates."

That the Board find the formulation and adoption of these rules do not impose excessive regulatory cost on any licensee and any cost to comply with the proposed rule cannot be reduced by a less expensive alternative that fully accomplishes the objectives of the applicable laws.

That the Board find that it is not legal or feasible to met the objectives of the applicable laws to adopt or implement differing actions for businesses as listed at O.C.G.A § 50-13-4(a)(3)(A),(B),(C) and (D).

REVIEW HEARING

The Board conducted a Review Hearing of an Initial Decision in the matter of Luther Vance, M.D., Respondent. The Review was held at the request of the Respondent. Leslie Claxton, Hearing Officer, presided over the Review. Respondent was present, and represented by Attorneys Adrienne E. Marting and Scott Rees. Amelia Baker, Assistant Attorney General was present and represented the State. A court reporter was present to record the proceedings.

Respondent testified and his attorney delivered oral arguments. Amelia Baker delivered her oral arguments. After questions from the Board all parties left the hearing while the Board deliberated in Executive Session.

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Dr. Hill moved to uphold the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order suspending Respondent's license to practice as a physician in Georgia in conformity with the terms of the initial decision. Drs. Woolery and Summers recused. Dr. Finley seconded and it carried with Drs. Stewart, Lewis and Walden voting no.

Dr. Hill moved to go into Executive Session to conduct Investigative Interviews, Dr. Lewis seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. Dr. Kamath then declared the meeting would be open session upon completion of the investigative interviews for the purpose of holding committee meetings.
