Dr. Perry called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

Dr. Cheeks moved to approve the agenda of the April 1, 2010, GCMB meeting. Dr. Butler seconded, and it carried unanimously.

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Dr. Cheeks moved to approve the minutes of the March 4, 2010, GCMB meeting with amendments. Dr. Retterbush seconded and it carried unanimously.

APPEARANCE BEFORE THE BOARD –Holly Snow, Vice President, Government and External Affairs at Piedmont Healthcare

Holly Snow, Vice President, Government and External Affairs at Piedmont Healthcare, requested an appearance before the Board with associates Chuck Ballard, M.D., Director of Catheterization at the Fuqua Heart Center at Piedmont, William Knopf, M.D., Chief Operating Officer Piedmont Heart institute, Tracy Files, MS, JD, Partner, Arnall Golden,

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Gregory, LLC, for clarification and confirmation of what the Board believes to be the scope of practice of medicine concerning moderate sedation by Radiology Assistants – Respiratory Care Professionals – Certified Cardiac Technicians. The Board advised them to rephrase the question and resubmit it.

Kevin Edmonds, M.D. requested an appearance before the Board to request to terminate probation. Dr. Able accompanied him. Dr. Edmonds made comments. Dr. Able made comments in support of Dr. Edmonds. The Board members asked questions. Dr. Cheeks moved to go into Closed Session. Dr. Weil seconded and it carried unanimously.

Dr. Perry declared Open Session. Dr. Sumner moved to uphold the original decision of denial. Dr. Retterbush seconded and the motioned carried.

Dr. Gross moved to go into Executive Session to conduct Investigative Interviews, Dr. Lee seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. Dr. Perry then declared the meeting would be in open session upon completion of the investigative interviews for the purpose of holding committee meetings.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

LaSharn Hughes, Executive Director, presented the following to the Board:

1. Review of one day meeting dates for July and September.
2. Regarding a letter from David Westfall, M.D. concerning body art operators – Class 1 Device that uses dermal punches to install jewelry or surface anchors asking if the Board has a position on this. Board will assign a study committee for more information. Dr. Westfall also had concerns about non-physicians applying tattooing around the eye as part of permanent make-up. Board advised this is a felony they are guilty of illegal tattooing.

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3. Regarding an email from Charles Nix concerning transferring duties to a nurse tech under the direction of a RN that are currently done by a RCP. Advised transferring these duties violated State Law.
4. Regarding an email from Heather Combs concerning a pharmacist requesting to provide Coumadin management and the autonomy to be able to manage some other medications as it relates to patients. Requesting guidance to develop an internal protocol giving her the authority to do so. Board advised the protocol could be approved for one specific protocol for management.
5. Regarding a letter from Gary R. McCain, Attorney at Law concerning a physical therapy practice using dry needling procedures. Refer to Acupuncture law.
6. Kimberly Peruski submitted an email asking for information regarding state guidelines for conscious sedation in a practice setting for a Multi-specialty group. Refer to rules and laws.
7. Dr. Trotter, DC asked if a chiropractor who has earned a MD degree may put his degree on business cards while awaiting scores on the USMLE? Advised you can say you have a degree in medicine and name your medical school, but you cannot put M.D. on your business cards.
8. Regarding an email from Dr. Wells concerning a patient of his refusing to pay for medical records and his obligation to release the medical records if the parties refuse to pay. Advised the physician is under no obligation to provide medical records to this patient if he/she refuses to pay.
9. Elizabeth Ruddiman requested advice about the requirement that applicants have to be retired to have a volunteer license. For instance, would a MD “or physician” that works for CDC and is on active duty in the US Public Health Service be considered as retired? Advised a physician would have to actually be retired to qualify for a volunteer license.
10. Pathology Lab at the Medical College of Georgia asked if they can do testing on themselves or family members; is such self-ordering permitted? There is nothing in the Laws and Rules that prohibits this.
11. Does Pathologist living out of state need a medical license from Georgia to read a specimen from Georgia? Yes they must have a Georgia license.

Physical therapists use the exact same tools and techniques as acupuncturists to perform dry-needling. This is the "ahshi" (meaning where it hurts) form of acupuncture. The committee affirms that this is the practice of Acupuncture.
