GEORGIA SOCIETY OF ANESTHESIOLOGISTS – Presentation Guidelines for Office Based Surgery.

Richard S. Hawkins, M.D., President, The Georgia Society of Anesthesiologist, Inc., Steven L. Sween, M.D., James E. “Jet” Toney, Executive Secretary, presented their recommended guidelines for office based surgery. The Board members asked questions. The Board invited the Society to send a representative to the monthly Rules Committee meeting.

ED REPORT CONTINUED

4. Discussed Death Certificate meeting at the capitol. Reviewed draft information sheet for physicians. Table until September meeting.
5. Reviewed report listing states that fail to report disciplined caregivers to federal database. The Board does not license or has not taken any discipline on these professions.
6. Federation of State Medical Boards is collecting data on state board's history as they celebrate their Centennial in 2012. Reviewed facts for the Board.
7. Regarding a letter from Brad Borum from Kaiser Permanente, who was in attendance, regarding HB 1154 and age limitations which seem to conflict with CDC guidelines. Board members asked Mr. Borum questions. The board advised Mr. Borum that this matter does not apply to the Medical Board but does apply to the Pharmacy Board.
8. Michelle Kump requested the requirements for medical director for an insurance provider. Advised the medical director must be a licensed physician.
9. Rafael D' Auria, M.D. – requested a detailed explanation why the Board will not expunge his records for sexual allegations. A response was sent.
10. Regarding a request from Dr. Ali asking if he can use a rubber stamp of his signature. Board advised no.
11. Can physicians use an alias for politicians or athletes who may not want the public to know who they are? No this would be considered a falsification of medical record.
12. Is it a violation of the law for a pediatrician to refer adult patients to a hospital for treatment? Advised this is a hospital issue.

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13. Can a certified Medical Assistant with a certification in phlebotomy start IV's? Board advised no.
14. Who can help a surgeon with wound closure? Can a Physician Assistant or can a medical staff person help with a diploma in surgical technology, or certification from National board for Certification of Orthopedic Physician Assistants, or orthopedic technologist – surgery certified? Board advised no. They can assist the physician. Can not close independently.
15. Any requirements for a physician dispensing pre-packaged medications other than pharmacy board? Physician himself has to dispense medication.
