

Auricular Ear Detoxification Technician Application Checklist

Eligibility Requirements

____NADA Certification – Complete the National Acupuncture Detoxification Association (NADA) training program and obtain certification in Clean Needle Technique (CNT).

____Supervision Requirement – Must practice under the supervision of a licensed healthcare provider (e.g., acupuncturist) in a treatment facility.

Application, Fees, & Required Documents

____Complete Initial Application – Available on https://gcmb.mylicense.com/egov/Login.aspx.

____Application Fee – \$200 (non-refundable, payable via cashier's check or money order).

____Affidavit of Applicant (Form A) – Submit a notarized affidavit, including a passport-sized photo.

____NADA Training Certification (Form B) – Submit proof of completion of the NADA training program and Clean Needle Technique certification.

____State Board License Verification (Form C) – For applicants with out-of-state certification.

____Exposure Control and Infectious Disease Prevention (Form D) – Adherence statement. Applicant must provide three (3) references on official letterhead:

- One reference from a licensed U.S. physician (MD or DO) practicing in the same jurisdiction and familiar with the applicant's practice.
- Two references from practicing acupuncturists familiar with the applicant's practice.

____Certification of Completion of Nationally Recognized Training Program (Form E) – Must be completed by the Program Director and notarized.

____Chemical Dependency Program and Supervisor Information (Form F) – Must be signed by supervisor. ____Employer Professional Liability Insurance (Form G) – Rule 360-6-.06(5) requires an ADT licensee to be covered by the professional liability insurance of the licensee's employer.

____Immigration Status Verification – Non-US citizens verification with <u>SAVE Program</u>. Submit proof of qualified alien status to the Board (I-94, 797, or Permanent Resident card).

____Clean Needle Technique Course & Practical Examination – Submit proof of completion for NADAapproved CNT course.

License Renewal, Continuing Education, Rules & Laws

___Renewal Cycle & Fee – \$105 biennially (every two years).

____Continuing Education Requirements – Must complete 40 hours of board-approved CE including a minimum of 1 hour concerning infectious disease.

____Late Renewal Fee – \$205 if not renewed on time

____Reinstatement Fee – \$200 for lapsed/revoked licenses, \$100 for inactive licenses.
