CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Dalton called the meeting of the Georgia Composite Medical Board to order at 7:30 AM, and a quorum was established.

AGENDA

Dr. Bhat made a motion, seconded by Judy Gardner to approve the agenda of the June 2, 2022, meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

MINUTES

Dr. Bhat made a motion, seconded by Dr. Antalis to approve the minutes of the May 5, 2022, and the May 17, 2022, meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS FOR 2022-2023

The Georgia Composite Medical Board held its election of officers for 2022-2023. The term for these positions will begin June 30, 2022 and extend through the June 2023 meeting of the GCMB (exact date TBD).

Dr. Matthew Norman was appointed Chair of the Georgia Composite Medical Board, with Dr. Andrew Reisman as the Vice Chair of the Georgia Composite Medical Board.

Barby Simmons motioned and John Anatalis seconded this motion.

CHAIR'S REPORT

Dr. Dalton took a headcount for the June 30, 2022, meeting (which will be held via TEAMS). Dr. Dalton and Dr. Simmons will not be available for the Board meeting on June 30, 2022.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Mr. Dorsey shared updates from the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact:

- Connecticut becomes the 38th member jurisdiction to join the Compact.

Mr. Dorsey shared physician health news from a quarterly newsletter of FSPHP.

Mr. Dorsey also shared updates regarding Board staff which included current employees starting new roles, new hires joining the team and an updated contact list was also provided.

Mr. Dorsey also shared information regarding FY23 Strategic Plan.

Electronic Signatures were discussed with a plan to move forward and to implement this service.

Mr. Dorsey also presented a request for GCMB position/advisory opinion from an anonymous source:

- Question:
If a licensed physician is returning to work after recovery from a cerebrovascular event:
Should that be reported to the board prior to renewal period?
Is documentation from the neurologist that references improvement from speech pathologist sufficient (history of aphasia)? - Should a graduated return to work be based on neurologist recommendation? - Should there be recommendation for temporary oversight (monthly or weekly peer review for 1 -3 months) based on the neurologist recommendation? - does any of this documentation need to be submitted to the board?
- Answer: The physician should ensure that they are in compliance with the laws set forth.

Mr. Dorsey also presented a case regarding a physician and Walmart. The Board decided to open an investigation into the physician and into Walmart.
