Richard A. Kaul, MD, asked if he can be licensed in Georgia. The Board informed Dr. Kaul, he must apply for licensure before a determination can be made.

Randi Seigel ask if the Board prohibited business corporations from employing physicians and rendering medical services. The question was referred to the Office of the Attorney General for a response.

Nancy Allen, inquired if a physician can pay for the patient's expenses for surgery and bill them in the services. The Board advised against this practice, it may appear to be solicitation as noted in OCGA Sec. 43-34-8(6).
