## **PRESENTATION**

Dr. Butler presented material regarding the possibility of issuing an institutional license and proposed advantages and disadvantages by way of a rule change or rule waiver. Dr. Butler asked that we gather information from other state medical boards regarding institutional licenses before proceeding.

#### EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Ms. LaSharn Hughes recognized Dr. White as one of the 100 most influential people in Medicine by the Atlanta Business Chronicle. Ms. Hughes also announced Dr. Perry's resignation from the Board, effectively immediately at the close of the February Board meeting and thanked Dr. Perry for his years of service to the citizens of Georgia. A proclamation for Outstanding Citizen from the Secretary of State's Office was presented to Ms. Elizabeth Beavers, Compliance Manager for the Board, for her retirement scheduled at the end of February 2012.

Ms. Hughes presented the following report to the Board:

- 1. Letters requesting clarification of Rule 360-3-.06 were referred to Dr. Lee to address in the FAQ section on the website.
- 2. Regarding letters from Barbie Tucker and William King regarding physicians selling health products in their offices, the Board determined that it is not unlawful to do so and suggested that more information on Alternative Therapies can be found in OCGA 43-34-8.
- 3. In response to an email from Dr. B.T. Brown, a physician's order is required for a patient to be injected with Vitamin B-12.
- 4. In response to a letter from Richard Spector, MD, the Board is not aware of any problems regarding the practice of referring all after-hours calls to 911or the Emergency Room as being considered patient abandonment.
- 5. The Board tabled for more information the question regarding if a GA license is required to participate in a hands-on CME course in GA.
- 6. The Board referred Maureen Altman to the Georgia Drugs and Narcotics Agency for the definition of dispensing.
- 7. Psychiatrists who are prescribing medications for out-of-state college students may send or call in the prescriptions to a drugstore.
- 8. In response to an email from John Bossaller, Schedule II medications prescribed for the treatment of Attention Deficit Disorder are excluded from the requirements of the new pain management rules.
- 9. In a response to the email from Vicki Allison, a physician must have a GA physician license if he/she is in GA only to proctor another physician for a new technology or equipment.

- 10. Mr. Barry Cranfill addressed the Board regarding helping colleagues understand the risks being undertaken by participating in fee-splitting arrangements in their medical practices. The Board tabled for additional information.
- 11. The questions on the application and renewal forms regarding physical and mental disorder were tabled and referred to the Licensure Committee.
- 12. In response to a letter from Martha Phillips, dentists are authorized to inject Botox inside the oral cavity only.
