RULES HEARING

Dr. Sumner announced the Public Hearing.

Dr. Lee moved to adopt the proposed Rule and that the Board finds the formulation and adoption of these rules do not impose excessive regulatory cost on any licensee

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and any cost to comply with the proposed rule cannot be reduced by a less expensive alternative that fully accomplishes the objectives of the applicable laws.

That the Board find that it is not legal or feasible to meet the objectives is the applicable laws to adopt or implement differing actions for businesses as listed at O.C.G.A. § 50-13-4 (a) (3) (A), (B), (C), and (D).

Ms. Kinlaw seconded and it carried unanimously.

NURSE PROTOCOL COMMITTEE

Ms. Kinlaw presented the report for the Physician Licensing Committee. Dr. Weil seconded the committee recommendations and it carried.

Other Business:

1. The committee reviewed the documentation of training submitted by Jennifer Mobley, APRN for joint injection and hyfercation of lesion and recommends to the Board that the documentation meets the provision of OCGA 43-34-26.3.
2. The committee discussed the question from Debbie Thomason of the DEA regarding APRN's working for the Federal Veterans' Administration. The committee recommends to the Board that the APRN's, who are working in a VA facility under a state license from another state, be held to the standards for that particular state; and that if the APRN also has a GA license, then the GA license should be placed on inactive, if using the license from another state in the VA facility.
3. The committee discussed the information from the AG's office regarding the Emory flu vaccine protocols. The committee recommends to the Board that the flu vaccines at Emory can be performed under 43-34-26.1 or 26.3. However, if the protocols are being submitted under 26.3, then they must be compliant with 26.3.
4. The committee discussed the question from Emory Pilot Initiative regarding training documentation for lumbar puncture, frame placement for cranial stealth neurosurgery, and lumbar drain placement. The committee recommends that no specific number of procedures be performed, but that the documentation of training is submitted to the Board with the protocol registration, including number of procedures observed and performed under supervision, with patient outcomes.
