EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

LaSharn Hughes, Executive Director, presented the following to the Board:

1. Dr. Lee presented a proposed Rule concerning medical specialties. The proposed Rule was referred to the Rules Committee for review.
2. Regarding a letter from The American Board of Cosmetic Surgery, Inc concerning whether they can advertise that they are board certified. Board referred this matter to the Rules Committee.
3. Regarding a memo from the Office of Planning and Budget with the rates physicians can charge for copies of medical records. For information only.
4. Reviewed a chart of the new Committee Assignments for the Board. For information only.
5. Regarding the Board Organization Chart. Dr. Summers moved to approve with the addition of names, email, and telephone numbers for contact. Dr. Roundtree seconded and it carried.
6. Regarding a letter from Angela McEver asking if a medspa needs a medical director if there are two independent physicians that come in for treatments. Can there be two medical directors of one medspa? Table Request for more information as to what their med spa does.
7. Regarding a letter from Dr. Kirkpatrick asking if RN's must work under protocols for medication refills or prescriptions for post-op pain medications? Reply an RN does not require a protocol to call in prescriptions when they are following the doctor's orders.

Advised the Board it appears to indicate that a physician is permitted to have a nurse protocol agreement with APRN's who practice in a setting

- that is exempt from the four APRN limit and to delegate to more than four APRN's in that setting, while simultaneously having a nurse protocol agreement with no more than four APRN's who practice in a nonexempt setting.
