**NURSE PROTOCOL ADVISORY COMMITTEE REPORT**

Dr. Norman presented the APRN Committee Report as a motion. Dr. Marshall seconded, and the motion carried unanimously. The Board took the following actions:

**Questions:**

1. My client is a telehealth practice that has a physician and APRN who are both licensed in Georgia. The physician and APRN live within 50 miles of each other in Texas. They do not have a physical practice site in Georgia or any other state; they see all patients via telemedicine. They would like to enter an APRN protocol for the APRN to treat patients located in Georgia via telemedicine. Is this possible in Georgia? We are wondering if their

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living proximity satisfies the requirements in O.C.G.A. 43-34-25? **Their living proximities do not satisfy the requirements in O.C.G.A 43-34-25.**

2. Can a Locum Tenen, credentialed with an organization, be a delegating physician for NP's and PA's working in the same organization? **As long as the physician is licensed and following the rules and the primary practice location is within the state or within 50 miles of the practice location then it would be ok for the physician to be the delegating for the NP.**
  
3. I have a Hospital Client who is considering having APRN's admit patients to the hospital when the Supervising/Delegating Physician is not physically present at the hospital. This would be pursuant to a Nurse Protocol Agreement. We have searched and searched to find out whether this arrangement would be permitted in Georgia. Unfortunately, while we believe this would be an appropriate arrangement, we have not found a concrete answer that specifically allows APRN's to admit patients to a hospital without the delegating physician in-house. If the APRN's admission is permitted within the scope of practice, my Hospital Client would submit the Nurse Protocol Agreement between the APRN and the Delegating Physician for appropriate review. However, prior to undergoing that process, my Hospital Client wanted to see if the issue of APRN's admitting patients to the hospital when the delegating physician is not physically at the hospital had come before the Board before and, if so, whether such an arrangement would be permissible. My client certainly understands it would still have to fulfill all other requirements as outlined in O.C.G.A 43-34-25 and elsewhere. They are not trying to cut any corners and want to be sure this arrangement would be agreeable to the Medical Board. They also understand the Nurse Protocol Agreement would have to be approved by the Board. **It depends on the by-laws of the hospital.**
