That the Board find that it is not legal or feasible to meet the objectives is the applicable laws to adopt or implement differing actions for businesses as listed at O.C.G.A § 50-13-4 (a) (3) (A), (B), (C), and (D).

Dr. Summers seconded and it carried unanimously.

2. No interested persons were present to give oral comments at the public hearing or submitted written comments regarding the intention to amend Rule 360-8 entitled "Procedural Rules."

Dr. Cheeks moved to delete existing language regarding procedural rules to make this rule consistent with changes to the new Georgia Medical Practice Act, and to find the formulation and adoption of these rules do not impose excessive regulatory cost on any licensee and any cost to comply with the proposed rule cannot be reduced by a less expensive alternative that fully accomplishes the objectives of the applicable laws.

That the Board find that it is not legal or feasible to meet the objectives is the applicable laws to adopt or implement differing actions for businesses as listed at O.C.G.A § 50-13-4 (a) (3) (A), (B), (C), and (D).

Dr. Summers seconded and it carried unanimously.
