The Georgia Composite Medical Board (GCMB) held its regular meeting on February 2, 2017 at 2 Peachtree Street, NW Atlanta, Georgia to consider Medical Board matters.

CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Antalis called the meeting of the Georgia Composite Medical Board to order at 7:30 a.m.

AGENDA AND MINUTES

Dr. Weil submitted a motion, seconded by Dr. Gross, to approve the agenda of the February 5, 2017 meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

Dr. Marshall submitted a motion, seconded by Dr. Weil, to approve the minutes of the January 5, 2017 meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

BOARD CHAIR REPORT

1. Dr. Antalis asked for a head count for the March Board meeting, and the Federation of State Medical Boards dinner.

2. Thanked Dr. House for her faithful service to the people of Georgia as a member of the Georgia Composite Medical Board from January 28, 2010 through February 2, 2017.

3. Dr. Antalis appointed a subcommittee to review historical cases of sexual abuse. To review the cases, make recommendations and come up with solutions.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Mr. Jeffery presented the following information in his report to the Board:

- 1. Carol Dorsey plans to retire from the Georgia Composite Medical Board on March 31, 2017. Carol has served the people of Georgia faithfully since November 16, 2006 as a Board employee, and since October 2006 as a temporary staffing employee.
- 2. Effective January 16, 2017, Karl Reimers accepted the position of Deputy Executive Director. Karl served with the DCH Office of Inspector General from June 2011 to October 2015, when he joined the Board as Director of Investigations and Enforcement. Karl continues to direct the investigations and enforcement activities of the Board in addition to his new role as Deputy Executive Director.
- 3. Governor upholds Board's denial of laser practitioner licensure (active supervision certificate).
- 4. Request for guidance: Pain clinic utilization of practicing physician who is an independent contractor.
- 5. Request for guidance: Providing medical records when physician has declared bankruptcy.
- 6. Article from Florida Health "The DEA recently suspended McKesson Corporation's sales of controlled substances from distribution in Florida".

- 1. Request for guidance: Pain clinic utilization of practicing physician who is an independent contractor. Board replied even though they may have a separate agreement they are still employed. Refer to Rules Committee.
- 2. Request for guidance: Providing medical records when physician has declared bankruptcy. This is the physician's responsibility. Refer to the Laws and Rules
- 3. Article from Florida Health "The DEA recently suspended McKesson Corporation's sales of controlled substances from distribution in Florida".

Reviewed Legislation:

- 1. HB 36: Optometrists' administration of injectables
- 2. HB 40: Disclosure of rabies vaccination history by veterinarians to physicians
- 3. HB 55: Board member term limits
- 4. HB 157: Advertisement of specialty board certification
- 5. HB 165: Maintenance of Certification
- 6. SB 2: Expedited licensure provisions; advance notice to licensees of site visits/inspections
- 7. SB 47: Physicians in Georgia for sporting events

The Board took the following actions:

- 1. Stated its position that a pain clinic's utilization of a practicing physician requires Board approval regardless of whether the clinic is employing the physician as a paid employee or as an independent contractor.
- 2. Stated its position that a physician who has declared bankruptcy remains responsible for complying with the Rules and state laws regarding maintenance of patient records.
- 3. Stated its opposition to HB 36, based on concerns for patient safety if optometrists were permitted to administer certain pharmaceuticals by injection in and around the eye.
- 4. Stated its support for HB 40, based on enhancements to patient protection if veterinarians were required to provide information to the physicians of patients who suffered animal bites.
- 5. Stated its opposition to HB 55, based on concerns that board member term limits might have unintended consequences on the institutional experience and knowledge of professional licensing boards.
- 6. Stated its opposition to HB 157, based on concerns that patient safety could be adversely affected if physicians who participated in programs not sponsored by the ABMS or the Bureau of Osteopathic Specialists were permitted to hold themselves out as "board certified".
- 7. Reviewed HB 165 and noted that as the Board does not require specialty board certification or the maintenance of such certification as a condition of licensure, the bill would have no effect on physician licensing activities in Georgia.
- 8. Stated its opposition to SB 2, based on concerns that requiring the Board to provide advance notice of site visits for the purposes of verifying compliance could hamper the ability of the Board to conduct investigative activities.
- 9. Stated its support of SB 47, based on enhancements to patient care if visiting sports teams whose physicians did not hold Georgia licenses were permitted to treat team members at events and competitions held in Georgia.
- 10. Stated its support for SB 102, based on enhancements to patient care if an Office of Cardiac Care was established to designate and regulate emergency cardiac care centers in Georgia.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Dr. Retterbush submitted a motion, seconded by Dr. Gross, to go into executive session to discuss investigative matters. Dr. Antalis declared the meeting in executive session. Upon conclusion of the Board's discussion of confidential matters, Dr. Antalis declared the meeting in open session.
