Rule Chapter 360-13-.01. "Requirements for Board Certification"

Linda Goodfellow, Professor of Respiratory Therapy and Associate Dean for Academic Affairs Deans Office Respiratory Therapy was present to voice her agreement with the amended Rule

Dr. Gross made a motion to approve amended Rule Chapter 360-35-.2, "Requirements for Board Certification" with amendments. That the Board find the formulation and adoption of these rules do not impose excessive regulatory cost on any licensee and any cost to comply with the rule cannot be reduced by a less expensive alternative that fully accomplishes the objectives of the applicable laws; that the Board finds that it is not legal or feasible to meet the objectives of the applicable laws to adopt or implement differing actions for businesses as listed in O.C.G.A. 50-13-4(A) (3)(A),(B),(C), and (D).

Dr. Weil seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

ADVANCED PRACTICE NURSE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Dr. Callings presented the report of the APRN Advisory Committee as a motion. The Board approved unanimously

The Board took the following actions:

Correspondence

1. How does the Board feel about E-Signature from physicians? Do the protocol received by the Board need “wet” signature? Tabled until the July meeting.
2. Does the delegating psychiatrist have to see/treat the client or does evaluate mean evaluating the notes? Must be a face to face evaluation.

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3. I am trying to start a small business performing D. O. T physicals. First since I already have a delegating physician can I add a location to my application on file for work? Second Am I allowed to partner with my delegating physician. Third is there any way that I can make this my own business with my delegating physician's permission? – Follow the Law under the Federal D.O.T. Physical guidelines
4. At BHCC (Inpatient Unit), What are your recommendations to Delegating Physician when a NP prescribes controlled substance to a patient who is going to be there for only a few days? What are your recommendations to Delegating Physician when a NP prescribes controlled substance which is part of a protocol e.g. Ativan tapering regime for Alcohol Detox? At CAP are CSB's still Exempt from CAP of 4 NP/ 1 MD rule? Is there a (collective) CAP as to how many NP can be delegated by 1 Physician who is covering more than 1 entities (non CSB), as long as total number of NP per Facility stays below 4, could 1 Physician delegate (collectively) delegate > 4 NP? E.g. 2 NP at Facility #1 & 3 NP at Facility #2 – Refer to Rules
5. As a nurse practitioner with the hospitalist group (only working in the hospital setting), how do I obtain prescriptive authority? I do not want to prescribe any controls, just non-controlled medications (i.e. antibiotics, BP meds, diabetes meds, etc.) also only in the hospital setting. - Need Agreement
6. Why are the NP's approving protocols that do not follow the approved Medical Board, not Nursing Board guidelines? – File Complaint
7. Add to FAQ? – Does a CRNA need to have a protocol in place with their supervising physicians like Nurse Practitioners? Tabled until the July meeting
8. Add to FAQ? – When a Delegating Physician dies can the Designated Physician take over or does a new agreement have to be done along with the fee? Tabled until the July meeting.
