# CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Antalis called the meeting of the Georgia Composite Medical Board to order at 8:45 a.m.

# AGENDA AND MINUTES

Dr. Deloach submitted a motion, seconded by Dr. Gross, to approve the agenda of the November 3-4, 2016 meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

Dr. Retterbush submitted a motion, seconded by Mr. Wallace, to approve the minutes of the October 6, 2016 meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

# **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Mr. Jeffery presented the following information in his report to the Board:

- 1. Attorney General's Opinion 2016-6. The Attorney General opined that a physician is required to report payments made pursuant to a high-low agreement even when the jury returned a verdict in favor of the defendant (physician), and that the Board is authorized to conduct an investigation into the matter.
- 2. Attorney General's Opinion 2016-7. The Attorney General opined that while RNs and LPNs are not authorized to register for access with the state's Prescription Drug Monitoring Program, physicians may delegate their access to the PDMP to their employees who are RNs and LPNs.

- 3. A letter from Kenny Lyles requesting the Board's clarification of whether a license is required to operate the Cryolipolysis Slimming System, a machine used in the Cool-Sculpting procedure, or if the supervision of a physician or other licensee is required.
- 4. A letter from Kierston Winan requesting the Board's clarification of whether or not an advanced practice registered nurse practicing telepsychiatry must meet the patient in person for the first meeting.
- 5. Correspondence from Anne Foster asking the Board for its approved form of written disclosure that a physician must use when disclosing financial interest in an entity to which the physician is referring a patient, or if the Board had no approved form, for the procedure by which a physician could obtain the Board's approval of such written disclosure.
- 6. The 2016 Annual Report to the Boards on the United States Medical Licensing Examination.
- 7. A call for nominations to elected offices of the Federation of State Medical Boards.

The Board took the following actions:

- 1. Stated its position that state law should be amended so that physicians are not required to report to the Board any payments made under a high-low agreement when the jury returned a verdict in favor of the defendant physician, and that requiring such payments to be reported could have the consequence of increasing medical malpractice litigation costs.
- 2. Stated its position that the malpractice payout amounts in O.C.G.A. 43-34A are so low as to include payments made to settle nuisance lawsuits, and that state law should be amended to update the threshold amounts.
- 3. Resolved to invite Georgia Drugs and Narcotics Agency Executive Director Rick Allen to a future meeting to discuss any coming changes to the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program in the wake of Attorney General's Opinion 2016-7.
- 4. Named Dr. Downey and Mr. Jeffery as the Board's representatives to the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program.
- 5. Stated its position that Cool-Sculpting is among the procedures utilizing microwaves, ultrasound, and/or radiofrequency that are the practice of medicine, and referred the matter to the Rules Committee.
- 6. Asked Dr. Collins, Dr. House, and Dr. Gross to provide information concerning the standard of care in psychiatry, and whether videoconferencing could provide a level of care at least equivalent to an in-person assessment.
- 7. Asked Ms. Wray to provide information to Anne Foster concerning her inquiry about written disclosure of financial interest.
- 8. Thanked the Medical Association of Georgia for its resolution supporting the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact.
