Dr. Butler called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

Dr. Retterbush made a motion, seconded by Dr. White, to approve the tentative agenda of the December 6-7, 2012 meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

Dr. Retterbush made a motion, seconded by Dr. DeLoach, to approve the minutes of the November 1-2, 2012 Board meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

LaSharn Hughes, Executive Director, presented the following information for the Board's review:

- 1. The schedule of Board Meetings has been updated through December 2013.
- 2. The Board will issue a report on its performance goals to the Governor's office in December 2012.
- 3. A Bill to amend Code Section 50-36-1 regarding requirements for affidavits of lawful presence in the United States has been prefiled in the Georgia House of Representatives.
- 4. Walter Gamewell (Curly) Watson, MD of Augusta, GA passed away at the age of 102. He was on national news when he turned 100, and was actively practicing medicine in Augusta.
- 5. The Georgia Composite Medical Board traces its beginnings to 1825 and <u>Dr. Milton Antony</u>, Dean of the Medical Academy of Georgia in Augusta. Concerned by an influx of a "roving legion of quacks," Dr. Antony and the Medical Society of Augusta persuaded the state legislature to create the Georgia Medical Licensing Board, with Dr. Antony as its first president.
- 6. Herbert Gunn, MD requested clarification as to whether a physician may perform physical therapy. The Board affirmed the physician's right to perform physical therapy, and cautioned that the physician cannot delegate the authority to perform physical therapy to anyone other than a licensed physical therapist.
- 7. Elizabeth Morgan, MD sent the Board a letter regarding clerkships and residency slots. The Board referred the issue to the Physician Licensing Committee.
- 8. E. William Schmitt, Jr., MD requested a waiver of the Board's continuing medical education (CME) requirements, or an extension of time to complete the required CME. The Board approved a 6-month extension, upon the motion of Dr. Lee. Dr. Retterbush seconded the motion.
- 9. The Federation of State Medical Boards (FSMB) called for submissions of resolutions for the 2013 annual meeting of its House of Delegates.
- 10. The FSMB published a report of its Maintenance of Licensure Workgroup on clinically inactive physicians.
- 11. A bill promoting telehealth under Medicare and other Federal health care programs has been submitted in the United States House of Representatives.
- 12. Ed Goldstein, MD requested an exemption from the Board's continuing medical education requirements. The Board approved the exemption, upon the motion of Dr. Lee. Dr. Retterbush seconded the motion.
- 13. The FSMB issued a call for comments from its member boards regarding the drafts of two revised policies on the use of opioids in pain management and the treatment of opioid addiction in the medical office.

- 14. Mandy Clements, Moultrie Center for Adult & Pediatric Healthcare, PC requested clarification of the drug testing requirements in Rule 360-3-.06, "Pain Management." The Board referred her to the Rules of the Composite Medical Board and the laws of the State of Georgia.
- 15. James Bell, Georgia Taxpayers Alliance, Inc., requested information about the Patient Review Panel for the Controlled Substance Therapeutic Research Act. The Board referred him to the Rules of the Composite Medical Board and the laws of the State of Georgia.
- 16. *American Medical News* posted an article discussing nationwide physician shortages on its website, www.amednews.com.
- 17. The FSMB issued a survey to gather feedback from its member boards about its proposal to end the requirement for state medical board sponsorship of applicants to take Step 3 of the United States Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE). The Board referred the issue to the Physician Licensing Committee.
- 18. The FSMB issued a call for nominations for its annual awards to recognize remarkable achievements and outstanding service to the profession of medicine.
- 19. The Board of Nursing requested the Medical Board's consideration of a suggestion to seek updates to Georgia statutes regarding the definition of "advanced practice registered nurses" in Chapters 23 and 25 of Title 43. The Board asked for additional information before making a decision.
- 20. The request from Alan Kaiser regarding graduation from PA school was tabled.

RULES HEARING

The Board heard comments from interested parties on its proposed amendments to Rule 360-3-.02, "Unprofessional Conduct Defined" and Rule 360-3-.07, "Practice Through Electronic or Other Such Means." Dr. White made a motion, seconded by Dr. Gross, to refer the proposed rule amendments to the Rules Committee for further review.

CLOSED MEETING

Dr. White made a motion, seconded by Dr. Gross, to go into closed session to discuss pending litigation, Investigative and Wellness matters. The motion carried unanimously.
