8. Angelo Spinola regarding client AstraZeneca Pharmaceuticals LP – wants to conduct a independent medical examination. Mr. G has filed a lawsuit in California against AstraZeneca. They want to bring in a physician to conduct a medico-legal evaluation for psychiatric examination. Must have a Georgia medical license.
9. Janet Puthuparampil sent a email regarding New York licensed surgeon contacted by Georgia nurses, PAs, physicians and provide a short patient history and then ask a specific question to wound care, or if the patient is a candidate for hyperbaric medicine. Must have a license to practice medicine in Georgia.
